Campground Rules and Regulations

Free camping is available for SLRF Vendors, Entertainers and Volunteers.

All campers must comply with the rules below.

All campers must complete and submit a completed camping permit application.

Issuance of Campground Passes/Camping Spaces:

1. Campground passes and camping permits are issued to the registered participant (I.E. Vendor, Entertainer, Volunteer.) at the time of check in.
2. All passes are issued to person 18 or over. Minors may also camp, but must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian at all times while in the camping area.
3. Each campground resident will be assigned a campsite by the Site Coordinator(s).
4. All campers are required to carry a campground pass and a government issued photo ID at all times.
5. All guests in the campground area, from Friday afternoon through Monday morning, will be issued a campground pass. The pass must be on the individual at all times along with a government issued photo id (Drivers License, photo ID, or passport).
6. Anyone in the campground area without his or her campground pass and supplemental identification can be asked to leave at any time.
7. If camper loses their pass, it must be reported to Silver Leaf management within 24 hours. The camper must be able to present photo id and pay a \$5 fee before a new camping pass will be issued.

Camping Space Availability:

1. First priority for camping is to out of town vendors and entertainers.
2. Second priority for camping is to out of town volunteers
3. Third priority for camping it to entertainers, vendors, and volunteers who reside within the 100 mile radius.

4. All people who wish to use the Silver Leaf campground must complete and submit a camping application at least 10 days prior to the event.
5. Camping will be assigned on a first come, first served basis.

General Camping rules

1. All campers must have proper dress on their bodies at all times.
2. Each camper is responsible for his/her own camping area. It must remain neat and debris free at all time.
3. All trash should be deposited in the dumpster located on site. Please remove trash in a timely manner.
4. Vehicular traffic is limited to pick-up and drop off of camping supplies. All cars are to be parked in designated areas. Violation of this policy will result in suspension of camping and/or parking privileges.
5. Quiet hours begin at 10pm every night. No loud noises will be permitted after this time.
6. Lights out is at 12 am each day. Any noise above a whisper is unacceptable. Violators of this rule will have their camping privileges revoked.
7. Campfires are allowed in designated areas only. These are cleared areas and properly circled by rock or a suitable substitute. Sand, Water and or fire extinguishers must be kept nearby. Use common sense and caution with all campfires, SLRF reserves the right to prohibit any and all campfires.
8. Adults are encouraged to keep drinking to a moderate level.
9. State Law prohibits the consumption of alcohol by minors. Alcohol consumption by minors in the camping area will lead to the suspension of camping privileges for the offending parties and possible legal action from the State of Michigan.
10. Drug use is prohibited under state law. Failure to comply will result in the expulsion of the offender from SLRF and possible legal action from the State of Michigan.
11. Campers are expected to be aware and respectful of the wishes of others.
12. Campers are expected to provide their own camping equipment, and dress for conditions.
13. Any violation of federal, state, or local laws can, and will, result in revocation of camping privileges.
14. Each campsite is required to have a responsible adult staying in the camper/tent or campsite at night and their name listed on the application.

15. Anyone who violates the Silver Leaf camping rules will have their camping permit revoked. They will be required to leave the fair grounds and remove their camper/tent from the grounds within 12 hours. If not removed, their camper and/or gear will be removed by SLRF management.
16. If you have an animal you wish to bring, please contact the Site Coordinators at site@silverleafrenfaire.org.
17. Permitted animals must remain in a pen or on a leash at all times. They must be under control and non-disruptive to other campers.
18. No animal is allowed on festival grounds during the event. There are no exceptions to this rule.
19. All camping will be issued at 400 sq. ft. of space. The camping site will be issued, based on need, by the site coordinator(s). All campers must remain within the set camping site assigned.
20. Electric and Water hook-up is available on a very limited basis. All available is available on a first come, first served basis. The fees for water and electric hook-ups are as follows:
 - \$40 for both electric and water hook-up accessibility
 - \$30 for only electric hook-up accessibility
 - \$10 for only water hook-up accessibility
 - \$50 additional charge for those using air conditioning
21. Security is not provided for the campground by SLRF. You are responsible for the security of your own possessions.
22. Silver Leaf is not responsible for any loss or theft that may occur while you are residing in our campground. If a theft occurs, Silver Leaf encourages you to contact the proper authorities.
23. When departing your campsite for good, please make sure your campsite is free of all debris and all trash is deposited in the dumpster.
24. All hook-up fees are due in full at time of camping check in. You will not be connected to any electrical and/or water source without payment.
